Dear Parents/Carers of Children in Year 6

School Journey to Broutel, France – 22nd 26th February 2021

I am pleased to tell you that we have been lucky enough to be able to re-book our School Journey to France for the week commencing 22nd February 2021. Current Government guidance still advises against domestic (UK) overnight and overseas educational visits but we are hoping that this will have changed in time for our trip.

The cost is slightly less than the original booking, at £396.00 per child. This includes full board accommodation, activities, excursions and all transport. If you have already paid your £30 deposit (and any other payments), these will be carried forward. Any over-payments will be refunded. If you have not paid a deposit but would now like your child to attend, a £30 deposit should be paid via ParentPay by this Friday, 11th September 2020.

As we have previously said, we do appreciate that this is a lot of money and a new payment instalment scheme is available to help spread the cost of the trip, if you require it. Payments will be required as follows:

Deposit (£30)	-	11 th September 2020 (you can change the default amount to £30 in ParentPay)
1 st Instalment of £50	-	2 nd October 2020
2 nd Instalment of £50	-	6 th November 2020
3 rd Instalment of £50	-	4 th December 2020
4 th Instalment of £50	-	8 th January 2021
5 th Instalment of £50	-	5 th February 2021
6 th Instalment of £50	-	5 th March 2021
Final instalment of £66	-	1 st April 2021

We will be applying for a group passport, which will allow all children on the trip to travel to France.
