God Created the World In Seven Days

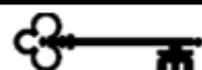
Day One:	Day Two:
On day one, God separated the dark from the light. He called the light 'day' and the dark 'night'.	On the second day, God created the sky. God separated the water into sea and sky.
Day Three:	Day Four:
On the third day, God commanded the sea to gather together so dry land would appear. He called the dry land 'earth'. He also created trees and plants.	On day four, God created the sun, moon and stars. This helped separate day and night.
Day Five:	Day Six:
On the fifth day, God created living creatures to inhabit the sky and sea.	On the sixth day, God created many land animals and the first human beings.

The Christian creation story explains how the world was created. Genesis, the first book in the Bible, describes how God created the world and everything in it.

Christians believe that before the creation of the world, there was God and nothing more. However, God wanted to create something to display His glory.

The creation story is very important to Christians as it reminds them of how God is all-powerful and all-loving.

The story also reminds Christians to be stewards of His creation.



Key Learning

- The Bible shows that God wants to help people to be close to him — he keeps his relationship with them, gives them guidelines on good ways to live (such as the Ten Commandments).
