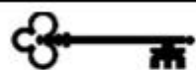


Incarnation ? Big Question: Was Jesus the Messiah?

Key Learning

- Jesus was Jewish.
- Christians believe Jesus is God in the flesh.
- They believe that his birth, life, death and resurrection were part of a longer plan by God to restore the relationship between humans and God.
- The Old Testament talks about a 'rescuer' or 'anointed one' — a messiah. Some texts talk about what this 'messiah' would be like.
- Christians believe that Jesus fulfilled these expectations, and that he is the Messiah. (Jewish people do not think Jesus is the Messiah.)
- Christians see Jesus as their Saviour (Salvation).

Key Vocabulary

Messiah	Jesus chosen by God to bring salvation to humankind.
Prophecy	Seeing into the future with God's help.
Trinity	The Father, The Son and The Holy Spirit.
Incarnation	God in human form
Saviour	Jesus
Anointed	To rub, sprinkle or pour on the head an oil to bless or make sacred in a ceremony.
Transformation	An inward change occurring inside of a believer as they take Christ into their lives.
Transfiguration	An event in Jesus' life in which his appearance was radiantly transformed.
Revolution	A sudden, radical, or complete change in the world.
