Aims of Breakfast Club

We provide good quality childcare for the children of St Botolph's School aged between 4 and 11. We aim to provide a nutritious and filling breakfast which will prepare your child for the school day. We are committed to providing equal opportunities for play and participation and we will ensure that your child(ren) have a safe and happy time at Breakfast Club.

We encourage children to use Breakfast Club as a social opportunity and at the same time to learn about the benefits of healthy eating. We all sit around the breakfast table until we have finished eating, then quiet play or activities are chosen. We encourage children to eat and drink something and provide healthy food such as cereals and toast and various spreads.

Opening Times

Breakfast Club is held in our lovely Studio building and is open every weekday during term time, excluding Staff Development Days, from 7.30am to 8.30am. Your children can be dropped off at any time between these times but **breakfast will only be served until 8.15am.**

There is no need to pre-book but **a registration form needs to be completed before first attendance at the club.**

Cost

Breakfast Club has a fixed cost of £3.00 per child, or £2.50 each for siblings who attend together. This cost includes a breakfast of toast, cereals, milk or juice. The cost does not change depending on the time your child arrives. Payment is required on the day of attendance and can be paid in advance for block bookings. Payment must be made online via School Gateway. We will not offer credit and we reserve the right to refuse further bookings if the full fee is not paid.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Welcome to St Botolph's C of E Primary School Breakfast Club!
Please take time to read these Terms and Conditions, as they will help with the smooth running of the club.

1. Charges

The cost of a place is £3.00 per child per day, or £2.50 each for siblings who attend together. This cost includes breakfast and activities. **Please note that breakfast is only served until 8.15am.** There is no reduction in cost for late arrivals. You may pay per session, weekly or termly and payments must be made online via School Gateway. Should you no longer require a place you have booked and paid for, you will be eligible for a refund if you give at least 24 hours' notice.

2. After Breakfast Club

Reception children will be taken to their classrooms by a member of the Breakfast Club. Year 1 children and upwards will make their own way to their classes.

3. Behaviour

Behaviour by any person 'on site' considered to be unacceptable and inappropriate will not be tolerated. Respect for, and proper use of, all property, equipment and the premises is essential and must be maintained by all persons (adult or child) at all times.

4. Confidentiality

All information exchanged by any person involved with the club will be kept confidential.

The success of the club depends on co-operation and sharing between all those involved. Parents should address any comments they wish to make to Kim Barton or one of the Breakfast Club Leaders.
