Dear Parents/Carers of Children in Year 6

Safety in Action – Tuesday 12th July 2022

Year 6 has been allocated a place at Safety in Action, which will be held at Cobham Hall, Cobham on Tuesday 12th July 2022. This is an event specifically designed for pupils who are about to transfer to secondary school, where children spend half a day learning how to identify and deal with potentially dangerous and sometimes life-threatening real-life situations. There are various scenarios that the children have to deal with, which include being approached by a stranger, reacting to a fire, road safety and dealing with an accident, being offered drugs etc.

All children should wear school uniform and will need to have a packed lunch and a water bottle (no glass please), which can be refilled onsite if required. Please contact the School Office if your child is eligible for free school meals and you would like a packed lunch to be provided by the school.

The cost of the trip is £11.00 per pupil; could we please ask that consent and payment be made via ParentPay by Friday 24th June. You will also be asked whether you give permission for your child to be photographed for any promotional Safety in Action media.

A GDPR consent form will be sent home with your child, which should be completed and returned to school by Friday 24th June.

In the event of an emergency, we will use the contact and medical details held on file for your child. Please contact the School Office as soon as possible if any of these details have changed. If you DO NOT agree to medical treatment or anaesthetic being given should the need arise, please inform the school before the date of the event.

If your child suffers from asthma, please ensure that he/she brings their asthma pump on the day of the outing. In line with school policy, asthma sufferers should keep their medication (inhaler) readily available at all times and we suggest that pumps are carried in a 'bum bag', which is worn around the waist.
